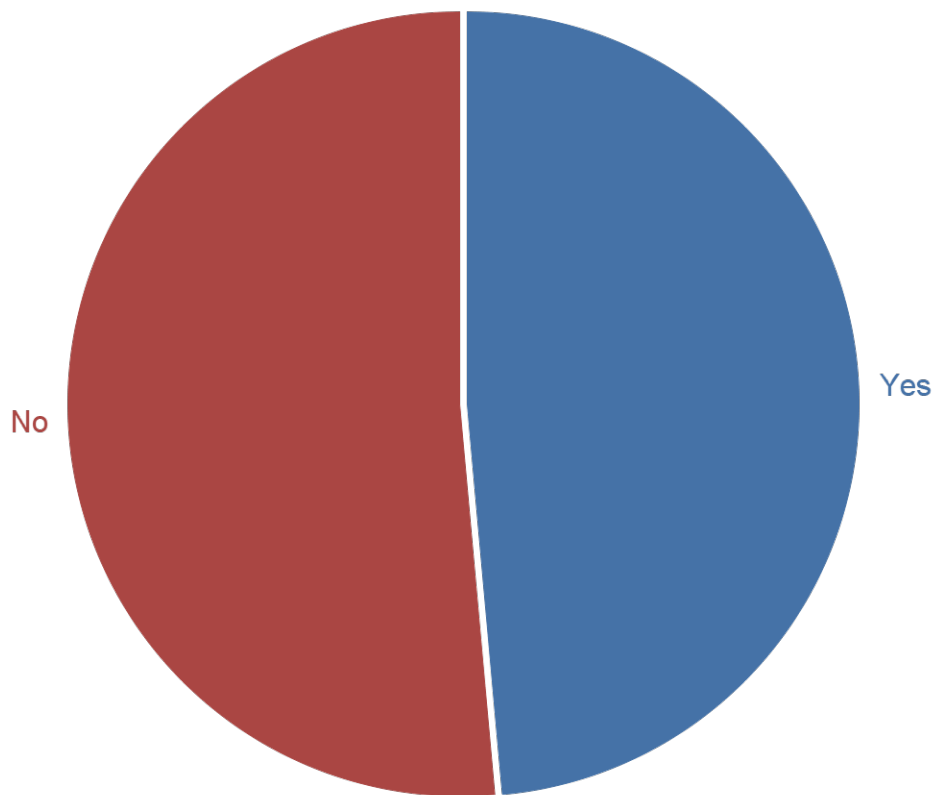

Overall, what is the reputation of the Kenyon Art History program among your peers?

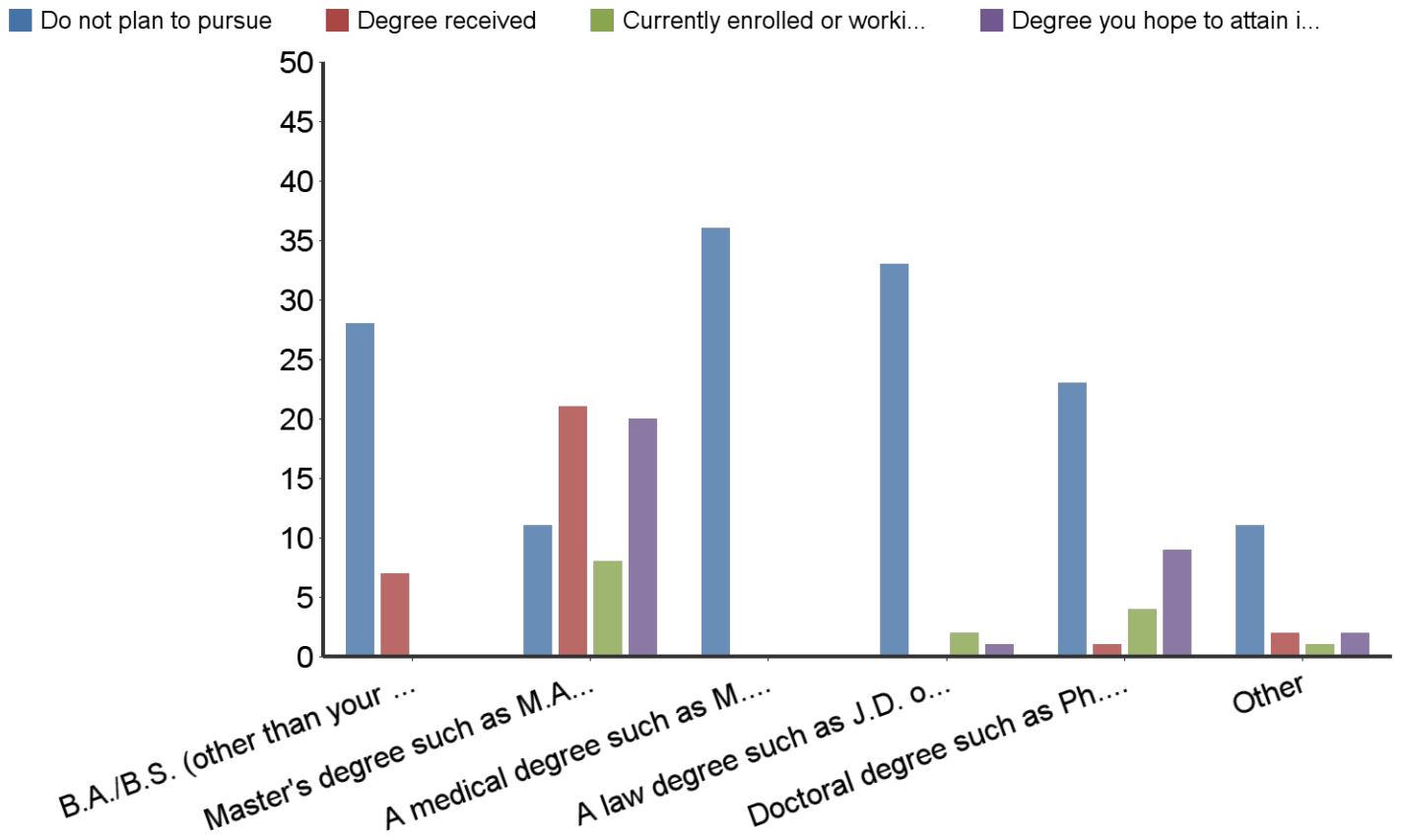

Is your current primary activity in the field of Art History or a related field?



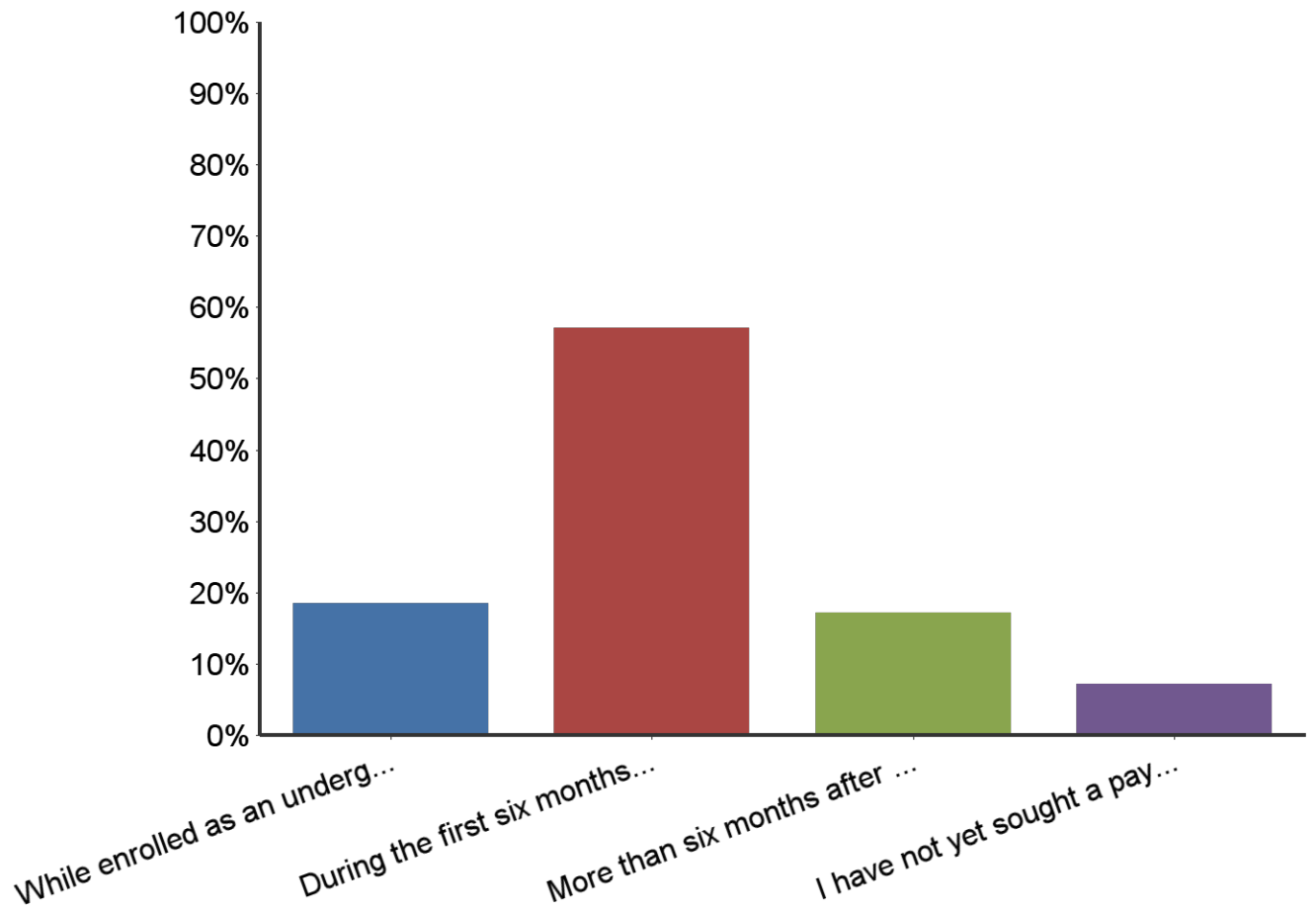

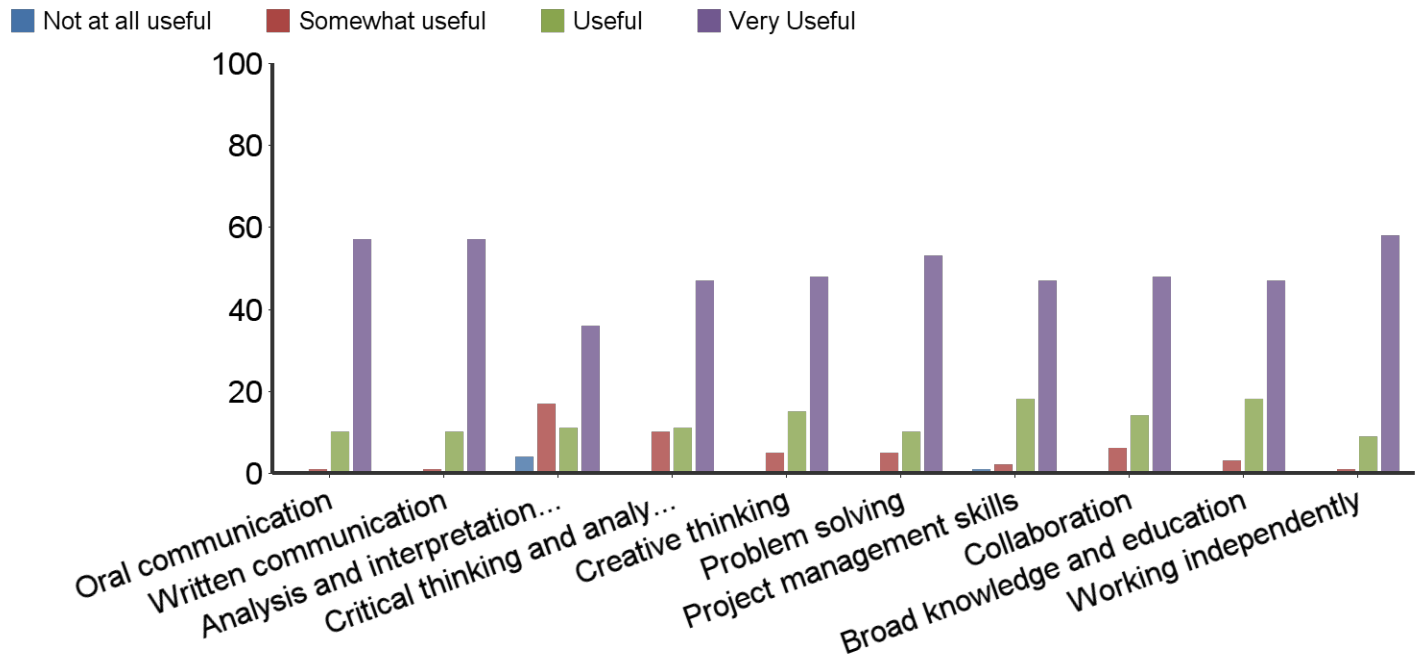

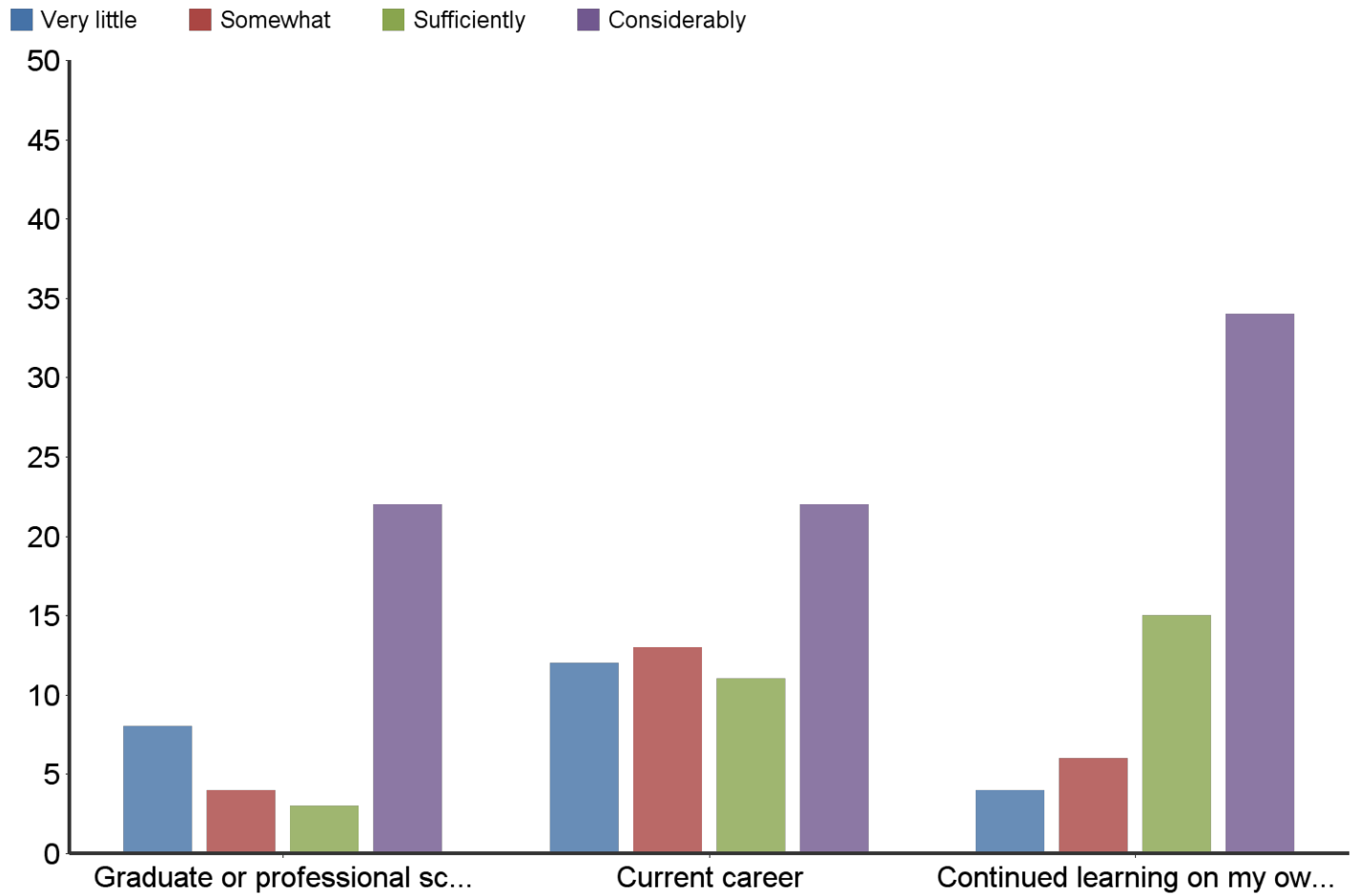

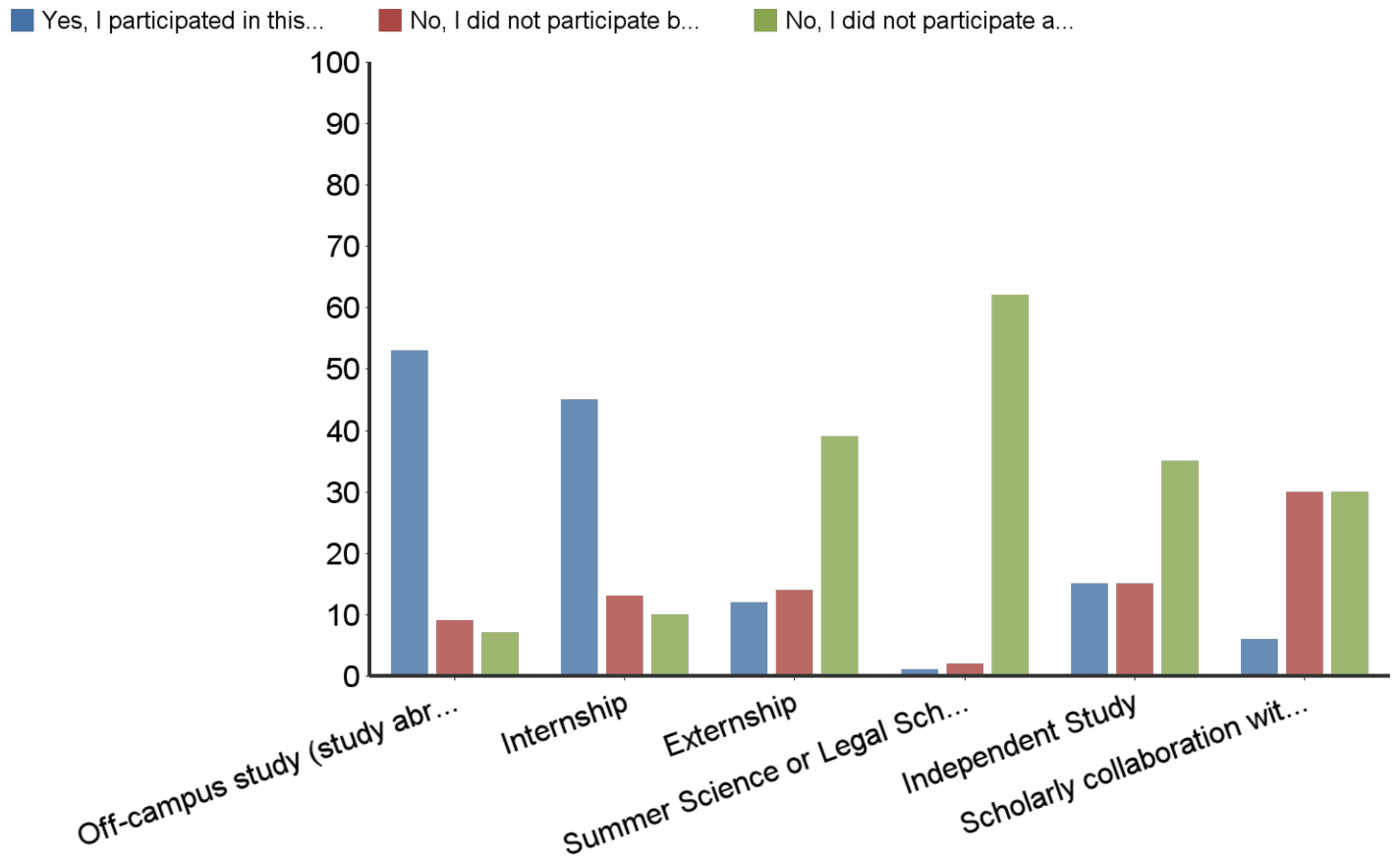

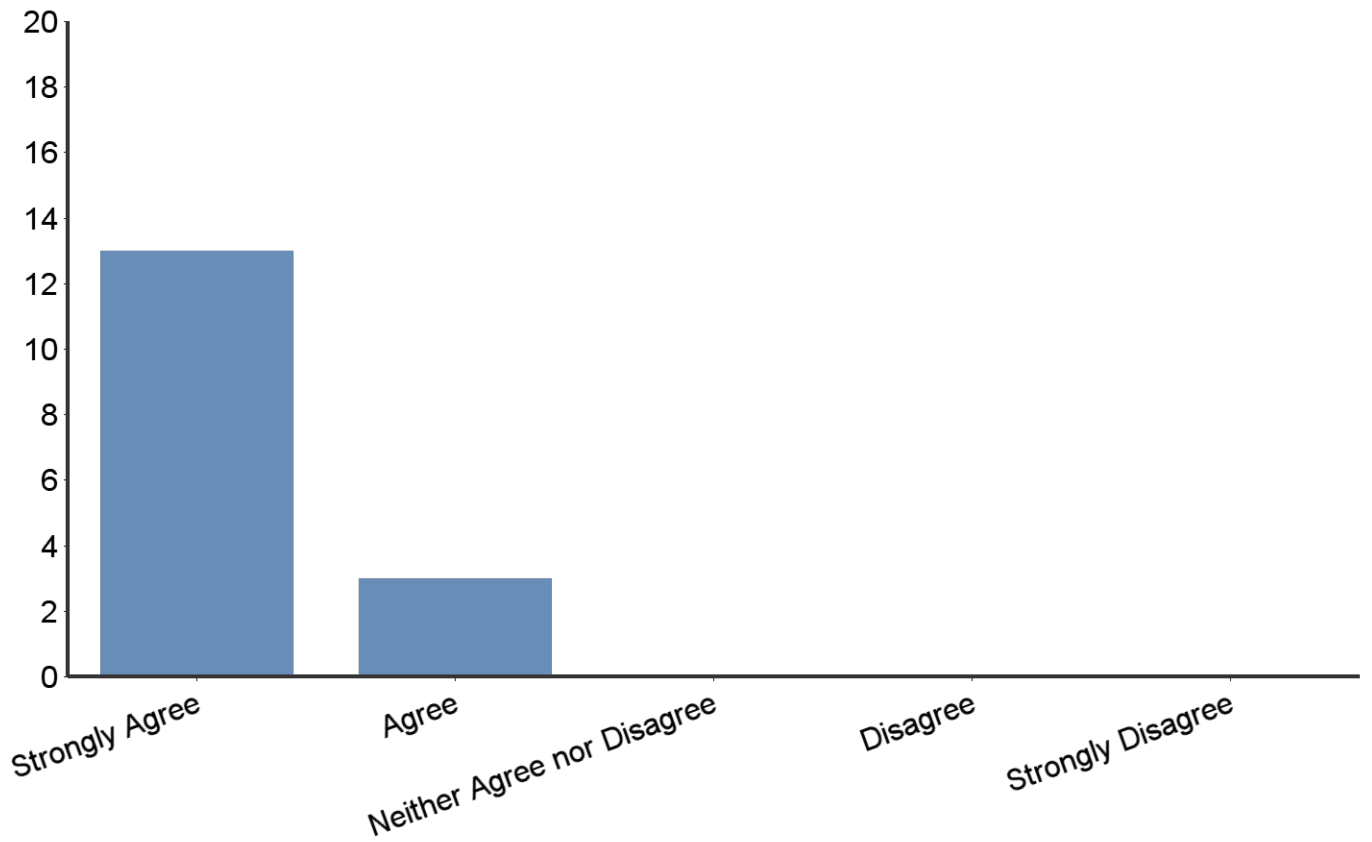

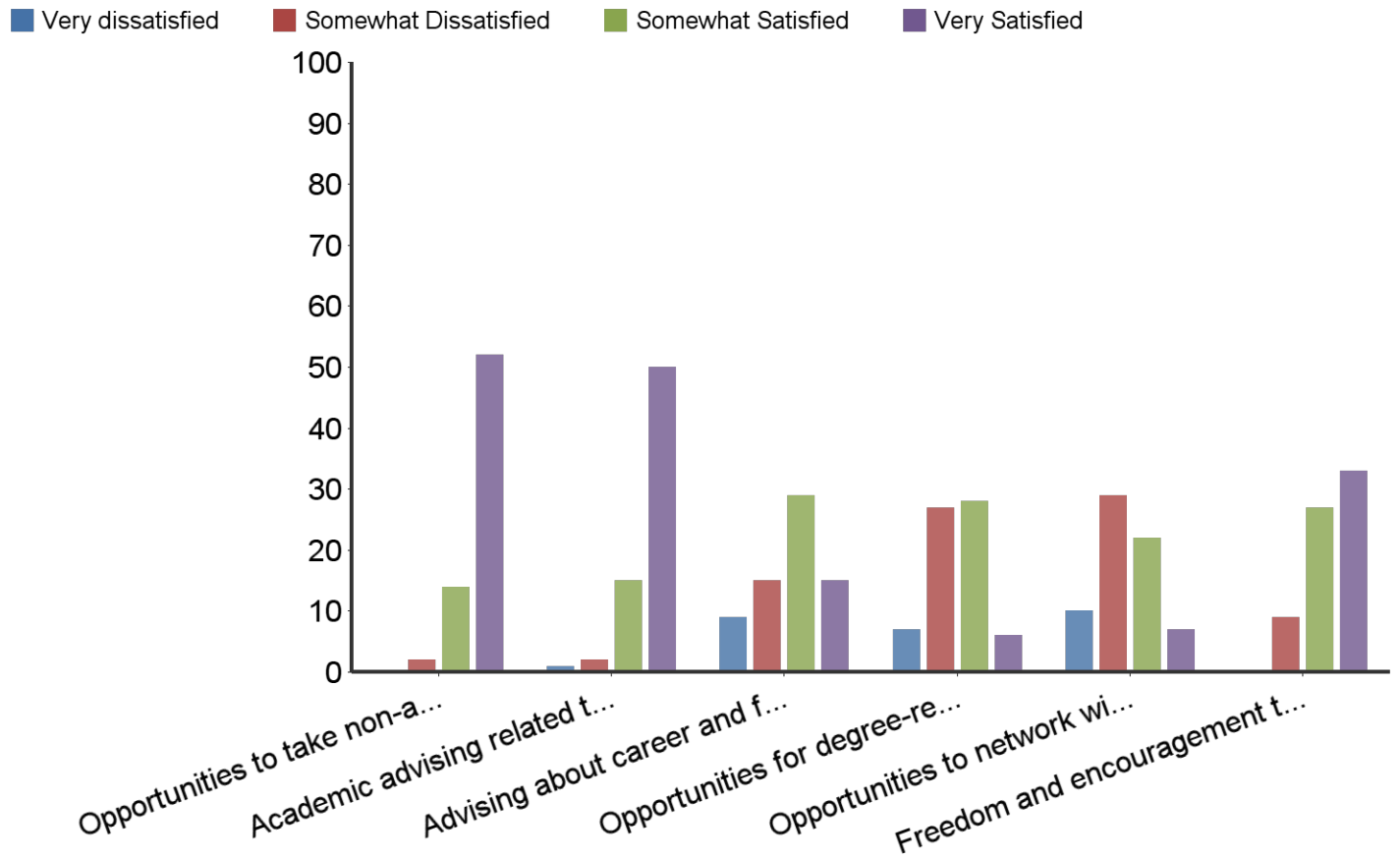



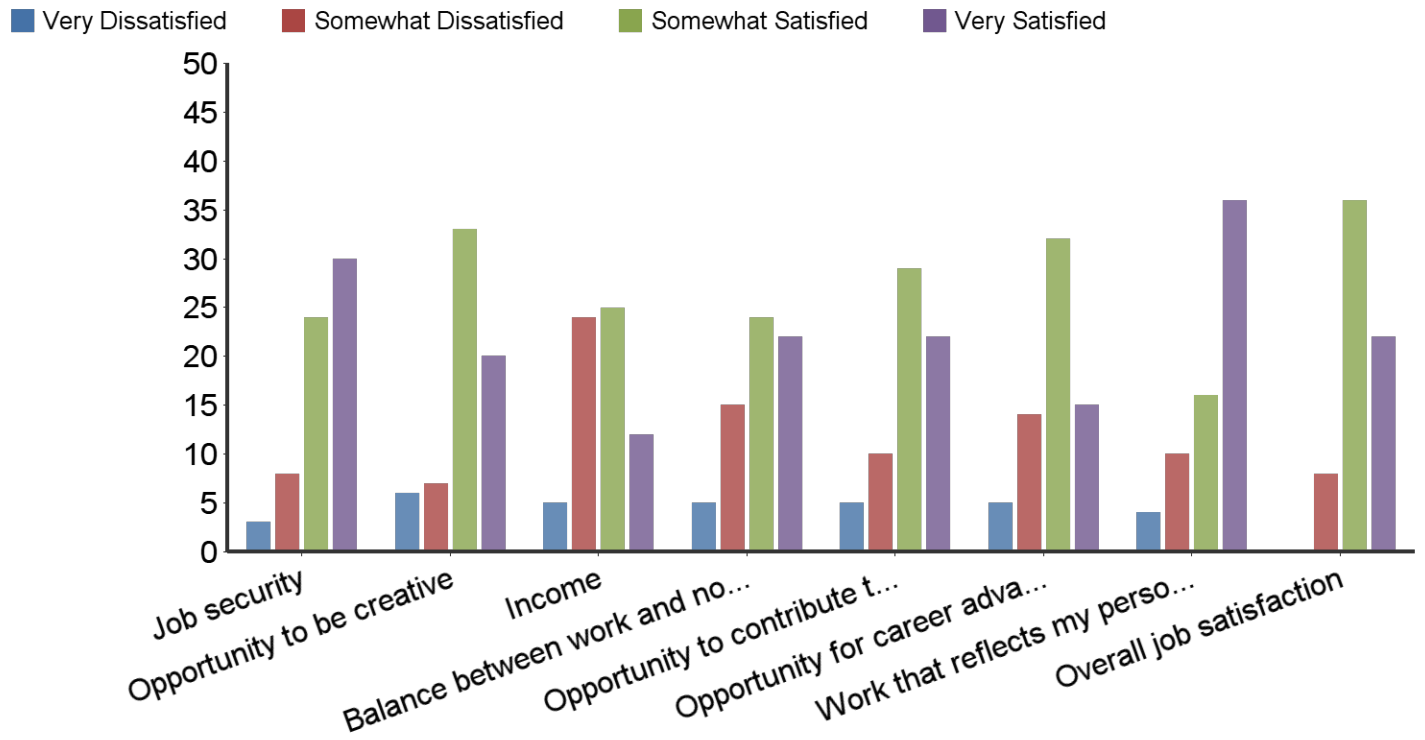
