What is GoBus?

GoBus is a non-profit, grant funded Rural Intercity Bus service. Our objective is to connect Ohio's rural communities to urban centers and beyond. We strive to provide safe, reliable, & affordable transportation to all.

Where Does GoBus Go?

GoBus stops in 39 cities & towns across Ohio. Some of our most popular stop locations include Columbus, Cleveland, Cincinnati, Batavia, Akron, & Athens. We make connections with Greyhound & other national bus carriers in many cities. We even stop at the Columbus airport!

What Does it Cost to Ride GoBus?

We strive to keep our fares as low as possible. Fares vary in price based on the distance traveled. One-way tickets start at just \$5 (plus taxes & fees). To travel from Mt Vernon to Columbus, for example, costs \$10 one-way (plus taxes & fees).
