

The following timeline outlines the major steps the College has taken to address student concerns.

3.23.20
College announced plans to pay student workers through the remainder of the semester, whether or not their duties could be performed remotely.

3.31.20
College adjusted grading policies to provide faculty and students maximum flexibility in handling evaluations for spring 2020.

6.17.20
College introduced COVID emergency relief funds (spring 2020) and additional financial aid for special circumstances (2020-21).

8.11.20
College adjusted fees and aid for 2020-21, including a 10% tuition reduction; elimination of room, board and activity fees for the remote term; \$2K personal allowance for low-income students; conversion of need-based work-study to grant for the remote term.

9.28.20
President Decatur provided an update on the College's comprehensive review of student work experiences.

3.30.20
College announced plans to issue credits/checks for the unused portion of spring 2020 room and board fees.

4.22.20
College introduced Talkspace, an online therapy service, free to students year-round, wherever they are.

8.1.20
College granted Community Advisors a wage increase (from \$9.92 to \$11.17/hour) and further reduced room fee.

8.21.20
College adjusted student work policies for 2020-21, including ensuring that student workers will continue to be paid if they have to quarantine or if the semester is disrupted as well as creating opportunities for remote work.

College adjusted its financial aid renewal application to make the process less burdensome and to issue award letters sooner to assist with planning; the College also reminded students of all of the avenues for financial assistance.
