Notes:

- Student must complete a “Kenyon LCCC Pathway Form” as soon as they want to express interest. No commitment necessary. This will connect them to a Kenyon Admissions Advisor and alert Advisors/Coordinators at LCCC. It will also trigger a series of requests for additional information and paperwork along the way.
- A final Kenyon College application is due March 15 in the semester before expected entrance to Kenyon College.
- Kenyon has a residency requirement. For the final two years of the program (semesters five through eight) students are fully enrolled Kenyon students. Therefore, student must live on campus in dorms, participate in the meal service, and attend in-person classes. As part of this student engagement, student will have access to all campus services, opportunities, and activities.
- As outlined in the above pathway, student must complete the Associate of Arts degree from LCCC and a minimum of 64 semester hours at Kenyon.
