YES:

- Virtual meetings and events
- In-person meetings with 10 or fewer people, appropriate distancing and mandatory masks (indoors or outdoors)
- Hybrid meetings with 10 or fewer people, appropriate distancing and mandatory masks
- Grab-and-go in Peirce Atrium (with no students present)

MAYBE:

- Club sports should consult the Return to Sport protocols
- Knox County off-campus travel in very selective circumstances
 - Contact student.engagement@kenyon.edu for guidance and approval
- Food can be provided in a grab-and-go, individual serving format
- Events with up to 50 attendees (submit requests here)

NO:

- In-person activities where social distancing cannot be observed
- In-person activities without masks
- In-person activities with more than 10 participants
- Peirce tabling with student presence
- Social events with alcohol
- Club sport competition

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- When in doubt -- ASK! Let's work together on how to fit your idea within current guidelines.
